2	Whereas, Carroll E. Metzner was born on April 24, 1919, in Milwaukee,
3	Wisconsin, and died on December 6, 2008, in Madison, Wisconsin; and
4	Whereas, Mr. Metzner earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Northwestern
5	University in 1941 and a Bachelor of Laws degree from the University of
6	Wisconsin-Madison in 1943; and
7	Whereas, Mr. Metzner began his political career on the Madison city council
8	where he served from 1951 to 1956; and
9	Whereas, Mr. Metzner was first elected to the Wisconsin assembly in 1954,
10	representing Dane 3, serving in the 1955 and 1957 sessions; and
11	Whereas, during his tenure in the legislature, the legislature passed the
12	"Metzner bill," which restricted the height of buildings along the Madison
13	lakeshores; and
