



2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 700

March 15, 2012 - Introduced by Representatives BARCA, HINTZ, MILROY, MASON, BEWLEY, BERCEAU, MOLEPSKE JR, BERNARD SCHABER, D. CULLEN, ROYS, STASKUNAS, HEBL, TOLES, POPE-ROBERTS and C. TAYLOR, cosponsored by Senator VINEHOUT. Referred to Committee on Homeland Security and State Affairs.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 14.025 of the statutes; **relating to:** posting of gubernatorial
2 appointment vacancies on the Internet Web site of the Office of the Governor.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that, before nominating or appointing any person to a position in state government, the governor must post on the Internet Web site of the Office of the Governor the title of the position and a brief summary of the duties of the position. In addition, after such a position is filled, the governor must post on the Internet Web site all of the following: the title of the position; the name of the individual holding the position; the salary paid to the individual holding the position and the salary paid to the individual who previously held the position; and a brief summary of the qualifications of the individual holding the position.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 14.025 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **14.025 Gubernatorial appointments.** (1) Before nominating or appointing
5 any person to a position in state government, the governor shall post on the Internet

1 Web site of the office of the governor the title of the position and a brief summary of
2 the duties of the position.

3 (2) After a position identified in sub. (1) is filled, the governor shall post on the
4 Internet Web site all of the following:

5 (a) The title of the position.

6 (b) The name of the individual holding the position.

7 (c) The salary paid to the individual holding the position and the salary paid
8 to the individual who previously held the position.

9 (d) A brief summary of the qualifications of the individual holding the position.

10 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

11 (1) This act first applies to individuals nominated or appointed to positions in
12 state government by the governor on the effective date of this subsection.
