Ott, Bies, Knilans, Vos, Sinicki, Endsley and Brooks, cosponsored by Senators T. Cullen, Kedzie, Lazich, Holperin, Harsdorf, Schultz, Grothman and Miller. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: commending the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater football team
2	for winning a fourth national championship.
3	Whereas, the UW-Whitewater Warhawks became the National Collegiate
4	Athletic Association (NCAA) Division III champions for the fourth time in five years
5	with a 13–10 victory over Mount Union College on December 16, 2011; and
6	Whereas, Whitewater has now won three consecutive national championships,
7	extending its winning streak to 45 consecutive games, the longest active streak in
8	the NCAA; and
9	Whereas, Whitewater, having faced Mount Union in the Amos Alonzo Stagg
10	Bowl for the past seven years, now holds the edge winning four out of seven; and
11	Whereas, sophomore defensive lineman Loussaint Minett, a Whitewater High
12	School graduate, forced a Mount Union fumble on its own one-yard line, setting up
13	the Whitewater touchdown; and
