2011 SENATE BILL 529

February 28, 2012 - Introduced by Senator Grothman, cosponsored by Representatives Knilans, Thiesfeldt, Wynn and Craig. Referred to Committee on Financial Institutions and Rural Issues.

1 AN ACT to amend 145.01 (10) (a) 1. of the statutes; relating to: nonresidential
2 water treatment devices.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) regulates the construction, installation, and maintenance of plumbing. Plumbing includes piping, appliances, and equipment in connection with water systems, including water distribution systems, wastewater drainage systems, and stormwater use systems. The definition also includes water treatment devices connected with these systems. This bill excludes residential water treatment devices from the definition of plumbing.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 145.01 (10) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

145.01 (10) (a) 1. All piping, fixtures, appliances, equipment, devices, and appurtenances in connection with water supply systems, water distribution systems, wastewater drainage systems, reclaimed water systems, and stormwater
