2011 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 56

January 23, 2012 - Introduced by Senators MILLER and S. FITZGERALD, cosponsored by Representatives BARCA and J. FITZGERALD. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

Relating to: expressing the legislature's hope for a speedy recovery for 1 2 Representative Tamara Grigsby. 3 Whereas, Representative Tamara Grigsby was elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly in 2004 and has been reelected without opposition since 2006; and 4 5 Whereas, Representative Tamara Grigsby has been a fierce advocate for 6 children and working families as a social worker, family counselor, program manager 7 at the Wisconsin Council on Children and Families, university professor, and 8 legislator; and 9 Whereas, Representative Tamara Grigsby has worked long hours and made a 10 deep commitment to the state budget process as a member of the Joint Committee 11 on Finance; and 12 Whereas, Representative Tamara Grigsby passionately protects the interests of people in her Milwaukee district and speaks with conviction, intelligence, and 13 14 eloquence on behalf of Wisconsin citizens; and
