## **2011 SENATE RESOLUTION 20**

September 1, 2011 - Introduced by Senators Risser, Lassa, S. Coggs, Grothman, Schultz, Taylor and Hansen. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1	Relating to: recognizing the centennial of the establishment of the Republic of
2	China (Taiwan).
3	Whereas, National Celebration Day, also known as Double Ten Day, is
4	celebrated every year on October 10th to commemorate the 1911 Wuchang Uprising,
5	which led to the collapse of the Qing Dynasty in China; and
6	Whereas, that milestone was quickly followed by the establishment of the
7	Republic of China (Taiwan) on January 1, 1912, under the leadership of the visionary
8	Dr. Sun Yat-sen; and
9	Whereas, the Republic of China (Taiwan) is both the first and the oldest
10	republic in Asia; and
11	Whereas, the Republic of China (Taiwan) is a vibrant democracy and economic
12	powerhouse that protects human rights, governs through the rule of law, and
13	continually seeks participation in international affairs; now, therefore, be it
14	Resolved by the senate, That the members of the senate offer their
15	congratulations to President Ma Ying-jeou on the centennial year of the founding of

the Republic of China (Taiwan) and a century of social, political, and economic achievements; and, be it further
