## ASSEMBLY BILL 4

October 11, 2011 – Introduced by COMMITTEE ON ASSEMBLY ORGANIZATION, by request of Governor Scott Walker, Representative Ripp, and Senator Lassa. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 38.41 (3) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** advanced  
2             manufacturing skills grants for technical colleges.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the Technical College System Board (board) makes grants to technical college system boards for training in advanced manufacturing skills. Beginning in the 2010-11 school year, the board is required to award at \$2,000,000 annually for such grants. This bill requires that, beginning in the 2011-12 school year, the board must award at least \$2,400,000 annually for such grants.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 38.41 (3) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

4             38.41 (3) (d) Beginning in the ~~2008-09~~ 2011-12 school year, the board shall  
5             award at least ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$2,400,000 annually under sub. (1) for training in  
6             advanced manufacturing skills, ~~and beginning in the 2010-11 school year, the board~~  
7             shall award at least ~~\$2,000,000~~ annually under sub. (1) for such training.

8             **SECTION 2. Fiscal changes.**

1 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation  
2 to the technical college system board under section 20.292 (1) (eh) of the statutes, as  
3 affected by the acts of 2011, the dollar amount is increased by \$400,000 for the first  
4 fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect to increase  
5 funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made. In the schedule under  
6 section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the technical college system  
7 board under section 20.292 (1) (eh) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011, the  
8 dollar amount is increased by \$400,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal  
9 biennium in which this subsection takes effect to increase funding for the purpose  
10 for which the appropriation is made.

11 **SECTION 3. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,  
12 except as follows:

13 (1) SECTION 1 of this act takes effect on the day after publication, or on the 2nd  
14 day after publication of the 2011-13 biennial budget act, whichever is later.
