2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 130

April 4, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives Petryk, Bies, Berceau, Bernier, Brooks, Kahl, Kolste, T. Larson, Mursau, Ohnstad, A. Ott, Sinicki, Spiros, Stone, Strachota and Nerison, cosponsored by Senator Petrowski. Referred to Committee on Veterans.

- AN ACT to amend 321.35 (1) of the statutes; relating to: the payment of travel
- 2 expenses of national guard members on state active duty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill allows a member of the national guard who is called into state active duty to receive the same amount of travel expenses as the federal government pays to an officer or enlisted member of equal rank in the corresponding branch of the U.S. armed forces. Currently, they are reimbursed the same amount of travel expenses as state employees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 321.35 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 321.35 (1) Every officer and enlisted person on state active duty in the national
- 5 guard shall receive the base pay and, allowances, and, notwithstanding ss. 16.53 (12)
- 6 (c) and 20.916 (8) and (9), travel expenses of an officer or enlisted person of equal rank
- 7 in the corresponding branch of the U.S. armed forces.
