2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 37

February 20, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives Krug, Jorgensen, Stone, Wright, Berceau, Bernier, Bies, Czaja, Hebl, Honadel, Kahl, Kolste, T. Larson, Mason, Ohnstad, J. Ott, Pasch, Pope, Richards, Ringhand, Ripp, Spiros, Swearingen and Smith, cosponsored by Senators Lassa, Moulton, Hansen, Miller and Shilling. Referred to Committee on Small Business Development.

- 1 AN ACT relating to: requiring the Wisconsin Economic Development
- 2 Corporation to organize trade and marketing forums for Tier I, Tier II, and Tier
- 3 III manufacturers and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation to allocate \$100,000 in the 2012–13 fiscal year to conduct trade and marketing forums in this state for the purpose of promoting and developing business relationships among Tier I, Tier II, and Tier III manufacturers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 4 Section 1. Nonstatutory provisions.
- 5 (1) In this Section:
- 6 (a) "Tier I manufacturer" means a business that produces or distributes a
- 7 product that is for sale or sold to a consumer.

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- (b) "Tier II manufacturer" means a business operating in this state that manufactures a product that is used as a part in a product produced or distributed by a Tier I manufacturer.
- (c) "Tier III manufacturer" means a business operating in this state that manufactures a product that is used as a part in a product produced by a Tier II manufacturer.
- (2) Of the moneys appropriated to the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation under section 20.192 (1) (r) of the statutes for the 2012–13 fiscal year, the corporation shall allocate \$100,000 to conduct trade and marketing forums in this state to bring together representatives of Tier I, Tier II, and Tier III manufacturers operating in this state to promote and develop business relationships among those manufacturers. The corporation may work together with nonprofit manufacturing associations and manufacturing assistance networks to accomplish the objectives of this subsection.
- (3) The Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation shall deposit any proceeds it collects in connection with trade and marketing forums under subsection (2) in an account established by the corporation that is dedicated to a manufacturer marketing assistance program to conduct marketing activities on behalf of, and to promote the manufacturing services of and products created by, Tier II and Tier III manufacturers. This subsection is void if 2013 Assembly Bill (LRB -0859/2) is not enacted.
