## 2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 427

October 17, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives TITL, BERNIER, KERKMAN, KNODL, LEMAHIEU, SPIROS and STONE, cosponsored by Senator LEIBHAM. Referred to Committee on State Affairs and Government Operations.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain religious, charitable, service, fraternal, veteran's, or tax-exempt organizations may obtain a Class A or Class B raffle license. A Class A raffle license allows an organization to conduct raffles in which at least some tickets are sold on days other than the day of the drawing. A Class B raffle license allows an organization to conduct raffles in which all tickets are sold on the same day as the drawing. Current law limits the price of a Class A raffle ticket to \$100. This bill increases the limit on the price of a Class A raffle ticket to \$500.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 563.93 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 563.93 (2) No raffle ticket may exceed \$100 \$500 in cost.
- 5 SECTION 2. Initial applicability.
