2013 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 111

March 10, 2014 – Introduced by Representatives C. TAYLOR, BERCEAU, JOHNSON, POPE, RINGHAND, SARGENT, SINICKI and ZAMARRIPA, cosponsored by Senators SHILLING, ERPENBACH, HARRIS, RISSER and L. TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: the rights of pregnant women.
2	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to bodily integrity; and
3	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to religious freedom; and
4	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to be free from cruel and unusual
5	punishment; and
6	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to be free from unjustified searches
7	and seizures; and
8	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to procedural due process, including
9	the right to effective assistance of counsel; and
10	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to equal protection under the law;
11	and
12	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to not be arbitrarily detained; and
13	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to autonomous decision making; and
14	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to have their end-of-life directives
15	and decisions honored by health care providers and institutions; and

1	Whereas, pregnant women have the right to receive confidential health care
2	that is provided with respect and dignity; now, therefore, be it
3	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That pregnant women
4	should be afforded all of the rights of non-pregnant people.
