2013 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 53

September 13, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives Jorgensen, Berceau, Bewley, Hulsey, Kahl, Kolste, Nass, Ohnstad, Pope, Ringhand and Wright, cosponsored by Senators T. Cullen, Erpenbach, S. Fitzgerald, Kedzie and Miller. Referred to Committee on Rules.

Relating to: commending WFAW-AM/WSJY-FM radio for 50 years of quality 1 2 community broadcasting. Whereas, WFAW-AM/WSJY-FM first went live "on the air" on September 4, 3 4 1959, touting itself as "the ultimate cow pasture radio," and, in the 50 years since its 5 continuous broadcast began in 1963, has become far more than that, providing news, 6 talk, and entertainment for tens of thousands of people in Jefferson, Dane, Rock, and 7 Walworth Counties; and 8 Whereas, the station has grown from eight employees using the most basic 9 broadcasting tools out of a trailer in a farm field, to 16 employees operating out of its 10 modern facility with state-of-the-art equipment; and Whereas, WFAW-AM/WSJY-FM's success can be attributed both to the 11 12 leadership of its owners, Robert K. Brown, Merlin Meythaler, Nathan Goetz, Robert 13 Goetz, Marathon Media, and NRG License Sub LLC, and to the outstanding work of 14 its employees, including general managers Tom Lawhead, LaVerne Falk, Scott

Trentadue, Gary Moen, Ben Rosenthal, and Jim Vriezen, and popular broadcasters
