2013 SENATE BILL 433

December 10, 2013 – Introduced by Senators PETROWSKI and GUDEX, cosponsored by Representatives CRAIG, SCHRAA, KESSLER, BALLWEG, BERNIER, CZAJA, JAGLER, KAHL, KNODL, KUGLITSCH, T. LARSON, LEMAHIEU, LOUDENBECK, MURTHA, NASS, OHNSTAD, PRIDEMORE, SANFELIPPO, SWEARINGEN and VRUWINK. Referred to Committee on Economic Development and Local Government.

AN ACT to create 125.09 (7) of the statutes; relating to: prohibiting 1 2 municipalities from providing alcohol beverages retailers with identification 3 scanners.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits municipalities from providing to alcohol beverages retail licensees any device capable of scanning a driver's license or identification card issued by the Department of Transportation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 125.09 (7) of the statutes is created to read: 4 5 125.09 (7) MUNICIPALITY PROVIDING IDENTIFICATION SCANNERS. No municipality 6 may provide, to any retail licensee under this chapter, any device capable of scanning 7 an official identification card, as defined in s. 125.085 (1) (a) and (b). 8
