## 2013 SENATE BILL 662

March 10, 2014 – Introduced by Senators OLSEN and LEHMAN, cosponsored by Representatives WEININGER, BALLWEG and A. OTT. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 AN ACT to amend 343.61 (2) (a) 3., 343.61 (2) (am), 343.61 (4) (b) and 343.62 (4) 2 (b) of the statutes; relating to: online instruction provided by driver schools 3 licensed by the Department of Transportation.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) licenses schools that give instruction, for compensation, in the operation of motor vehicles (driver schools). In an application for a driver school license, the applicant must identify all driver school office and driver school classroom locations. DOT may promulgate rules relating to driver schools and these rules currently include provisions relating to driver school classrooms. By statute, a driver school classroom is a facility that is approved by DOT and used to conduct driver training.

Under this bill, a driver school may provide driver training instruction by means of the Internet instead of, or in addition to, providing instruction at a driver school classroom.
