7	and became a combat engineer, serving in Korea until 2009; and
8	Whereas, Sgt. Chester Stoda was stationed at Fort Hood and deployed to
9	Afghanistan with the 8th Engineering Battalion in December 2010, where he was
10	responsible for locating and removing improvised explosive devices from roads; and
11	Whereas, Sgt. Chester Stoda received many awards and decorations, including
12	the Korea Defense Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal with campaign
13	star, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, two Overseas Service Ribbons, and
14	a Combat Action Badge, and was respected among his fellow soldiers and was
