2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 759

January 20, 2016 – Introduced by Representatives HEATON, EDMING, CZAJA, SPIROS and KULP, cosponsored by Senators Petrowski and Tiffany. Referred to Committee on Jobs and the Economy.

AN ACT to repeal 20.192 (1) (d); and to create 20.192 (1) (d) of the statutes; relating to: providing a grant to the Marathon County Development Corporation for a revolving loan program and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation to grant \$200,000 in the 2015–17 fiscal biennium to the Marathon County Economic Development Corporation to fund a revolving loan program for the purpose of funding minority-owned businesses.
