- 1 AN ACT to create 77.54 (63) of the statutes; relating to: a sales and use tax

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales and use tax exemption for feminine hygiene products. Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.
