2 Whereas, Emergency Medical Service (EMS) professionals honorably serve to
3 help countless Wisconsinites every year, oftentimes providing critical life-saving
4 treatments and rescue operations in their communities; and

5 Whereas, emergency medical personnel regularly place their own safety at risk,
6 often working in dangerous situations to help those in need of immediate care; and

7 Whereas, the Professional Ambulance Association of Wisconsin (PAAW) and
8 the American Ambulance Association (AAA) are dedicated to advocating and
9 promoting excellence in emergency medical care; and

10 Whereas, PAAW and AAA annually recognize as Stars of Life those EMS
11 professionals who stand out among their peers for their exceptional achievements in
12 emergency care and on September 24, 2015, honored 26 Stars of Life recipients at a
13 ceremony held in Green Bay, Wisconsin; and

14 Whereas, Stars of Life honorees are selected for their outstanding service and
15 personal qualities including: exceptional skills, selfless commitment, compassionate

1 care, positive image, and leadership in the development of community partnerships
2 or programs; and

3 Whereas, the 2015 Stars of Life honorees include those serving both rural and
4 urban areas across Wisconsin and represent the exceptional care that EMS
5 professionals provide residents of our state; now, therefore, be it

6 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the
7 Wisconsin legislature congratulate the 2015 Stars of Life honorees and commend
8 those receiving this award for their achievements and continuing dedication in
9 serving the residents of their community.
