2015 SENATE BILL 363

October 29, 2015 – Introduced by Senators LeMahieu, Gudex, Kapenga, Nass, Stroebel and Vukmir, cosponsored by Representatives Kremer, Born, Brandtjen, R. Brooks, Craig, Czaja, Edming, Gannon, Horlacher, Jacque, Kleefisch, Knodl, Krug, T. Larson, A. Ott, Sanfelippo, Schraa, Thiesfeldt, Tittl, Weatherston and Hutton. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

AN ACT *to amend* 943.13 (1m) (c) 5. of the statutes; **relating to:** trespass in university or college buildings while armed with a firearm.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill exempts any college or university in the University of Wisconsin System and any technical college from the law that allows a university or college to prohibit a person from carrying a firearm in any building on its grounds if the person holds a license to carry a concealed weapon. This bill also repeals the provision in the administrative code in which the University of Wisconsin System generally prohibits persons from carrying, possessing, or using any dangerous weapon on university lands or in university buildings or facilities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 943.13 (1m) (c) 5. of the statutes is amended to read:

943.13 (1m) (c) 5. While carrying a firearm, enters or remains in any privately or publicly owned building on the grounds of a university or college, if the university or college has notified the actor not to enter or remain in the building while carrying a firearm or with that type of firearm. This subdivision does not apply to a person

who leases residential or business premises in the building; to any building on the
grounds of a college or university in the University of Wisconsin System or on the
grounds of a technical college; or, if the firearm is in a vehicle driven or parked in the
parking facility, to any part of the building used as a parking facility.
Section 2. UWS 18.10 (3) of the administrative code is repealed.
