- 1 AN ACT to create 70.11 (47) of the statutes; relating to: a property tax exemption
- 2 for a winter sports club.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a property tax exemption for a nonprofit winter sports club that maintains ski jumps and cross-county ski trails in two contiguous counties.

Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 70.11 (47) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 70.11 (47) Nonprofit winter sports club. All property owned or leased by an
- 5 entity that is exempt from taxation under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code
- 6 that is used for cross-country skiing and ski jumping, if the entity maintains no less
