2015 SENATE BILL 586

January 15, 2016 – Introduced by Senators PETROWSKI and TIFFANY, cosponsored by Representatives HEATON, EDMING, SPIROS and CZAJA. Referred to Committee on Economic Development and Commerce.

1 AN ACT to repeal 20.192 (1) (d); and to create 20.192 (1) (d) of the statutes; 2 relating to: providing a grant to the Marathon County Development 3 Corporation for a revolving loan program and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation to grant \$200,000 in the 2015–17 fiscal biennium to the Marathon County Economic Development Corporation to fund a revolving loan program for the purpose of funding minority-owned businesses.

17	in section 16.287 (1) (f) of the statutes, who are U.S. citizens or persons lawfully
18	admitted to the United States for permanent residence, as defined under 8 USC 1101
19	(a) (20).
20	(2) Revolving loan fund grant. From the appropriation under section 20.192
21	(1) (d) of the statutes, the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation shall grant
22	\$200,000 to MCDEVCO, Inc., doing business as the Marathon County Development
23	Corporation, in the 2015–2017 fiscal biennium for a revolving loan program for
24	minority-owned businesses in Marathon County.
