2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 1031

March 20, 2018 – Introduced by Representative KRUG. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 118.46 (1) (intro.) and 118.46 (1) (a) 5. of the statutes; **relating** 2 **to:** the Department of Public Instruction's model school policy on bullying by 3 pupils.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the Department of Public Instruction to develop a model school policy on bullying by pupils. Under current law, DPI's model policy must contain certain components, including a procedure for investigating reports of bullying that requires notifying the parent or guardian of each pupil involved in a bullying incident. This bill requires that the parent or guardian of each pupil involved in the bullying incident be notified within 48 hours of the incident being reported to a school district employee.

SECTION 3. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) MODEL POLICY ON BULLYING. The department of public instruction shall
revise its model school policy on bullying under section 118.46 of the statutes to
comply with this act by August 1, 2018.
