



## 2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 1037

March 21, 2018 - Introduced by Representatives CROWLEY, C. TAYLOR, FIELDS, ANDERSON, VRUWINK, ZEPNICK, ZAMARRIPA and OHNSTAD, cosponsored by Senators JOHNSON and MILLER. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 343.18 (1); and *to create* 343.17 (7) and 343.21 (1) (Lm) of the  
2             statutes; **relating to:** electronic copies of operators' licenses.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill allows the Department of Transportation to issue a copy of an operator's license in an electronic format to the person to whom the operator's license is issued.

Under current law, a licensee must have his or her license document in his or her immediate possession when operating a motor vehicle and must display the license document upon demand from a traffic officer. Under this bill, the license document may be produced in either printed or electronic format.
