2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 1064

- March 22, 2018 Introduced by Representatives BERCEAU, SINICKI, SARGENT, ANDERSON, SPREITZER, C. TAYLOR, SHANKLAND and SUBECK, cosponsored by Senators SCHACHTNER and RISSER. Referred to Committee on Science and Technology.
- 1 AN ACT to create 20.255 (2) (dq) and 115.453 of the statutes; relating to: science
 - competition participation grants and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Public Instruction to award grants to teams of pupils in the 6th through 12th grades for the purpose of participating in science competitions. As a condition of receiving a grant, a team of pupils must demonstrate that it will provide funds to match the grant amount. DPI may not award a grant for this purpose in amount that exceeds \$5,000.

19	(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and exempt from taxation under section 501 (a) $% \left(1-\frac{1}{2}\right) =0$
20	of the Internal Revenue Code, having among its organizational purposes improving
21	the quality of elementary and secondary science education, increasing male, female,
22	and minority interest in science, creating a technologically-literate workforce, and
23	providing recognition for outstanding achievement by both pupils and teachers.

1 (2) (a) Annually, the department shall notify school boards, operators of charter $\mathbf{2}$ schools under s. 118.40 (2r) and (2x), governing bodies of private schools, and 3 administrators of home-based private educational programs that applications for grants under this section will be accepted from eligible teams through a date set forth 4 in the notice. As a condition of receiving a grant under this section, an applicant 5 6 eligible team shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the department that the 7 applicant eligible team will provide matching funds in an amount equal to the 8 amount awarded under this section.

9 (b) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (dq), the department shall award 10 a grant of up to \$5,000 to each eligible team selected from the applicants under par. 11 (a). Grant funds awarded under this section may be applied only towards allowable 12 expenses.

(3) The department shall publish on its Internet site a list of grant recipients
and submit to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature under s. 13.172
(3) a report on the program under this section.
