- AN ACT to amend 1.10 (4); and to create 1.10 (3) (u) of the statutes; relating 1
- 2 **to:** designating ginseng as the state herb.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill adds state herb to the list of state symbols and designates ginseng as the state herb.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 1.10 (3) (u) of the statutes is created to read: 3
- 1.10 (3) (u) Ginseng is the state herb. 4
