2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 347

- 1 AN ACT relating to: funding for science services positions in the department of 2 natural resources.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases moneys appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources by \$1,861,200 in fiscal year 2016–17 for the purpose of increasing science services positions by the equivalent of 18.4 full-time positions. This funding was decreased by this amount and these positions were eliminated under 2015 Wisconsin Act 55.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

9	under section 20.370 (3) (my) of the statutes, as affected by this act.
10	SECTION 2. Fiscal changes.
11	(1) ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY - LABORATORY CERTIFICATION. In the schedule under
12	section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of natural
13	resources under section $20.370(3)(fj)$ of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year
14	2016–17 is increased by \$103,800 to increase the authorized FTE positions for the
15	department by 1.25 PR science services positions.
16	(2) General program operations, nonpoint source - environmental fund. In
17	the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the
18	department of natural resources under section $20.370(3)$ (mt) of the statutes, the
19	dollar amount for fiscal year 2016-17 is increased by \$50,400 to increase the
20	authorized FTE positions for the department by 0.5 SEG science services positions.
21	(3) GENERAL PROGRAM OPERATIONS - STATE FUNDS. In the schedule under section
22	20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of natural
23	resources under section 20.370 (3) (mu) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal

year 2016-17 is increased by \$793,000 to increase the authorized FTE positions for
the department by 7.4 SEG science services positions.

4	year 2016–17 is increased by \$914,000 to increase the authorized FTE positions for
5	the department by 9.25 FED science services positions.
