## 2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 372

June 2, 2017 – Introduced by Representatives NOVAK, E. BROOKS and CONSIDINE, cosponsored by Senators MARKLEIN and ERPENBACH. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage.

1 AN ACT relating to: the sale of White Mound County Park to Sauk County.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Natural Resources to cede, grant, and convey all rights, title, and interest in White Mound County Park to Sauk County upon payment of \$1 by the county, on the condition that the property be used by the county for recreational purposes. The bill provides that, if the county does not use the property for recreational purposes, all rights, title, and interest in the park revert to the state. Under the bill, this transaction is not subject to the approval of the Natural Resources Board.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- (1) No later than 60 days after the effective date of this subsection and upon

- Mound County Park for recreational purposes, all rights, title, and interest in the
