## 2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 823

January 12, 2018 – Introduced by Representatives JACQUE, ALLEN, EDMING, HORLACHER, SANFELIPPO and WICHGERS, cosponsored by Senators WANGGAARD, COWLES and MARKLEIN. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 943.10 (1m) (intro.) of the statutes; **relating to:** entering 2 certain places with intent to commit battery and providing a criminal penalty.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, it is a Class F felony to enter a dwelling or certain other places with intent to steal or commit a felony therein. Under the bill, it is a Class F felony to enter one of those places with the intent to commit battery, regardless of whether the battery was a misdemeanor or felony battery.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 943.10 (1m) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 943.10 (1m) (intro.) Whoever intentionally enters any of the following places
- 5 without the consent of the person in lawful possession and with intent to steal or
- 6 commit a felony <u>or a violation of s. 940.19 (1) or 940.195 (1)</u> in such place is guilty of
- 7 a Class F felony:
