2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 856

January 19, 2018 - Introduced by Representatives Krug, Sargent, Hebl, Horlacher, Kolste, Jacque, Subeck, Considine, C. Taylor, Spreitzer, Sinicki and Berceau, cosponsored by Senator Johnson. Referred to Committee on Ways and Means. Referred to Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions.

1 AN ACT *to create* 77.54 (67) of the statutes; **relating to:** a sales and use tax exemption for diapers and undergarments for incontinence.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales and use tax exemption for diapers and undergarments for incontinence.

Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 77.54 (67) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 77.54 **(67)** The sales price from the sale of and the storage, use, or other consumption of diapers and undergarments for incontinence.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
