2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 971

- February 22, 2018 Introduced by Representatives HEBL, CROWLEY, ANDERSON, BERCEAU, OHNSTAD, POPE, SARGENT, SINICKI, SUBECK and C. TAYLOR, cosponsored by Senators L. TAYLOR, LARSON, MILLER, RISSER and VINEHOUT. Referred to Committee on Local Government.
- 1 AN ACT *to repeal* 66.1010 of the statutes; **relating to:** repealing the prohibition 2 against certain local governments from enacting or enforcing an eviction 3 moratorium on a landlord.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no city, village, town, or county may enact or enforce an ordinance that imposes a moratorium on a landlord from pursuing an eviction action against a tenant of the landlord's residential or commercial property.

This bill repeals that provision.
