



## 2017 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 36

April 25, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives C. TAYLOR, BERCEAU, WACHS, SINICKI, SHANKLAND, HEBL, MILROY, GANNON, SPREITZER, ANDERSON, KESSLER, TRANEL, ZAMARRIPA, CROWLEY, PETRYK, THIESFELDT, POPE, OHNSTAD, STEINEKE, ZEPNICK, SUBECK, BALLWEG, HESSELBEIN, NOVAK, SARGENT, VRUWINK and MURPHY, cosponsored by Senators RISSER, SHILLING, WIRCH, HANSEN, RINGHAND, DARLING, VINEHOUT and OLSEN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

- 1     **Relating to:** congratulating the University of Wisconsin–Madison Men’s Basketball  
2           team on its 2016–2017 season and advancing to the NCAA Sweet 16.
- 3           Whereas, the Wisconsin’s Men’s Basketball team had a record of 27 wins and  
4           10 losses, ranking the fifth highest total wins in school history; and
- 5           Whereas, Wisconsin holds the longest active streak in the Big Ten for reaching  
6           at least 20 wins for the 11th straight season; and
- 7           Whereas, the Badgers made 19 consecutive appearances to the NCAA  
8           tournament holding the fifth longest streak in NCAA history; and
- 9           Whereas, Wisconsin was the only school to advance to the Sweet 16 for four  
10          consecutive seasons and appeared six times in the last seven years; and
- 11          Whereas, since 2000, the Badgers have defeated the most No. 1 teams in the  
12          nation including this year’s No. 1 seed, Villanova, in the NCAA tournament; and
- 13          Whereas, Ethan Happ was named a third–team All–American and a first–team  
14          All–Big Ten; Nigel Hayes finished his career third in scoring at Wisconsin and a

1 selection in third-team All-Big Ten; Bronson Koenig was a second-team All-Big Ten  
2 selection and finished his career tenth on UW's all-time scoring list; therefore, be it

8 Gard, Lamont Paris, Howard Moore, and Joe Krabbenhoft along with other staff  
9 members whose contribution to the team helped make this a successful season; and,
