3	Whereas, free and charitable clinics increase access to primary health care for
4	uninsured and medically underserved Wisconsinites through innovative service
5	delivery models; and
6	Whereas, 75,000 individuals through 200,000 patient visits receive health care
7	at Wisconsin's 70 free and charitable clinics that provide life-saving health care in
8	over 50 counties; and
9	Whereas, 1,660 licensed providers volunteer at Wisconsin's free and charitable

11	Whereas, free and charitable clinics provide a multifaceted approach to
12	increase access to health care, dental care, and behavioral health, along with referral
13	services; and

2	developed and for every dollar donated to a free and charitable clinic five to seven
3	dollars of care is provided; and

7	hereby designates the first week of April 2017, and subsequent yearly anniversaries,
8	as Wisconsin Free and Charitable Clinic Week in Wisconsin.
