## 2017 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 91

December 28, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives STEFFEN, JACQUE, RIPP, SARGENT, SINICKI, MACCO and SPIROS, cosponsored by Senators COWLES, LASEE, MARKLEIN, RISSER and VUKMIR. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of Myron Lotto.

2             Whereas, former state legislator Myron Lotto was born on April 7, 1925, and  
3     died on October 31, 2017; and

4             Whereas, after his father's death, Myron Lotto took over the family farm at age  
5     17, and he later went on to serve the state of Wisconsin in the State Guard; and

6             Whereas, Myron Lotto was active in and dedicated to both state and local  
7     politics; and

8             Whereas, Myron Lotto served in the Wisconsin Senate from 1969 to 1973, where  
9     he served on the Committees on Labor, Taxation, Insurance and Banking, Housing  
10    and Urban Development, and Governmental and Veteran's Affairs; and

11            Whereas, Myron Lotto took a lead in drafting legislation to track criminal  
12    records and statistics, conserve and promote our natural resources, increase  
13    pensions for state employees, and more; and

1           Whereas, Myron Lotto served as Chairman of the former Town of DePere for 12  
2 years and successfully changed the town's name to the Town of Ledgeview to allow  
3 the community to form its own identity; and

4           Whereas, Myron Lotto was a member of the Brown County Board for 16 years  
5 and served as Chairman of the Board for six years; and

6           Whereas, Margaret Hutjens was Myron Lotto's wife of 66 years, and she  
7 preceded him in passing in April 2013; and

8           Whereas, Myron Lotto is survived and missed greatly by his children Michael  
9 Lotto, Nancy Pierce, Cindy Otto, Diane Studley, Lou Kidd, Bernie Lotto, and Denis  
10 Lotto, as well as his 14 grandchildren and 23 great-grandchildren; now, therefore,  
11 be it

12           ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the  
13 Wisconsin Legislature salute Myron Lotto for his years of public service and mourn  
14 his death; and, be it further

15           ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this resolution  
16 to Myron Lotto's children and grandchildren.
