## 2017 SENATE BILL 289

June 2, 2017 – Introduced by Senators FEYEN, TESTIN and DARLING, cosponsored by Representatives Allen, KREMER, THIESFELDT, HORLACHER, KLEEFISCH, TITTL and BRANDTJEN. Referred to Committee on Universities and Technical Colleges.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 36.09 (3) (a); and *to create* 36.11 (7m) of the statutes; **relating** 2 **to:** requiring University of Wisconsin System schools to offer degree credit 3 internships for each academic major.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, for each academic major offered at a University of Wisconsin System school, the school must offer a degree credit internship for which at least three credits toward completion of the academic major are awarded upon successful completion of the internship.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 be accountable and report to the president and the board on the operation and  $\mathbf{2}$ administration of their institutions. Subject to board policy and s. 36.11 (7m), the 3 chancellors of the institutions in consultation with their faculties shall be responsible for designing curricula and setting degree requirements; determining 4 academic standards and establishing grading systems: defining and administering  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 institutional standards for faculty peer evaluation and screening candidates for 7 appointment, promotion and tenure; recommending individual merit increases; administering associated auxiliary services; and administering all funds. from 8 9 whatever source, allocated, generated or intended for use of their institutions.

**SECTION 2.** 36.11 (7m) of the statutes is created to read:

11 36.11 (**7m**) DEGREE CREDIT INTERNSHIPS. The board shall ensure that, for each 12 academic major offered at an institution, the institution offers a degree credit course 13 that is an internship for which at least 3 credits toward completion of the academic 14 major are awarded upon successful completion of the course.
