2017 SENATE BILL 502

October 27, 2017 - Introduced by Senators Petrowski, Harsdorf and Marklein, cosponsored by Representatives Quinn, Edming, Skowronski, R. Brooks, Berceau, Zimmerman, Kuglitsch, C. Taylor, Tusler and Spiros. Referred to Committee on Government Operations, Technology and Consumer Protection.

- AN ACT to create 323.12 (4) (e) of the statutes; relating to: waiver of certain fees
- 2 during a declared state of emergency.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes the governor, during a state of emergency declared by the governor, to waive any fee required by the state for the replacement of a permit, license, approval, or other authorization for a person who resides or is headquartered in the area covered by the state of emergency.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 323.12 (4) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 323.12 (4) (e) At his or her discretion, waive any fee required by the state for
- 5 the replacement of a permit, license, approval, or other authorization for a person
- 6 who resides or is headquartered in the area to which the governor's executive order

- under s. 323.10 applies and whose permit, license, approval, or other authorization
- 2 is lost or destroyed in connection with the state of emergency.
