2017 SENATE BILL 540

November 20, 2017 - Introduced by Senators WANGGAARD, OLSEN and PETROWSKI, cosponsored by Representatives KULP, JACQUE, E. BROOKS, CROWLEY, JAGLER, MURSAU and SPIROS. Referred to Committee on Transportation and Veterans Affairs.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 347.07 (2) (intro.); and *to create* 347.14 (3) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** authorizing pulsing stop lamps on vehicles.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that a motor vehicle equipped with required stop lamps may be equipped with a center-mounted stop lamp that pulses up to four times in two seconds before displaying a continuous light.

Under current law, unless explicitly authorized or required by law, no person may operate on the highway a vehicle that displays any flashing light.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 347.07 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 347.07 (2) (intro.) Except as provided in sub. (3) or s. 347.14 (3) or 347.145, or
5 as otherwise expressly authorized or required by this chapter, no person shall
6 operate any vehicle or equipment on a highway which has displayed thereon:

7 **SECTION 2.** 347.14 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
