## 2017 SENATE BILL 559

November 20, 2017 – Introduced by Senators JOHNSON, WIRCH, CARPENTER and LARSON, cosponsored by Representatives Goyke, BOWEN, GENRICH, POPE, C. TAYLOR, BERCEAU, ANDERSON, SUBECK, ZEPNICK, VRUWINK, BROSTOFF, CROWLEY, FIELDS, RIEMER, YOUNG, OHNSTAD, SINICKI, ZAMARRIPA and SPREITZER. Referred to Committee on Agriculture, Small Business and Tourism.

1	AN ACT relating to: 2017-19 Authorized State Building Program, enumeration
2	of a building project involving the construction of a school of urban agriculture
3	in the city of Milwaukee, and granting bonding authority.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill amends the 2017-19 Authorized State Building Program to add one project for the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection. The project involves the construction of a Wisconsin School of Urban Agriculture in the city of Milwaukee. The project is financed with \$10,000,000 in general fund supported borrowing.
