2017 SENATE BILL 565

November 20, 2017 - Introduced by Senators Lemahieu and L. Taylor, cosponsored by Representatives Tittl, Tusler, Fields, Skowronski and Horlacher. Referred to Committee on Government Operations, Technology and Consumer Protection.

AN ACT to amend 1.10 (4); and to create 1.10 (3) (v) and 1.10 (3) (w) of the statutes; relating to: designating the bee balm (Monarda fistulosa) as the state wildflower and the monarch butterfly as the state butterfly.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill adds state wildflower and state butterfly to the list of state symbols and designates the bee balm as the state wildflower and the monarch butterfly as the state butterfly.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 1.10 (3) (v) of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 1.10 (3) (v) The bee balm (Monarda fistulosa) is the state wildflower.
- **SECTION 2.** 1.10 (3) (w) of the statutes is created to read:
- 7 1.10 (3) (w) The monarch butterfly is the state butterfly.
- 8 Section 3. 1.10 (4) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 8, is
