2017 SENATE BILL 591

November 29, 2017 - Introduced by Senators Erpenbach, Wirch, Johnson, Hansen and Vinehout, cosponsored by Representatives Considine, C. Taylor, Genrich, Hesselbein, Pope, Fields, Goyke, Zamarripa, Berceau, Subeck, Anderson, Billings, Sargent, Shankland, Kolste and Sinicki. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

AN ACT *to create* 302.075 of the statutes; **relating to:** first responders on duty at prisons.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, the warden or superintendent of each prison that houses maximum security inmates must ensure that at least five first responders, in additional to correctional officers and sergeants, are on duty at all times.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 302.075 of the statutes is created to read:
- **302.075 First responders on duty.** The warden or superintendent of each prison that houses maximum security inmates shall ensure that at least 5 first responders, in addition to correctional officers and sergeants, are on duty at the prison at all times.
