## 2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 958

February 24, 2020 – Introduced by Representatives HESSELBEIN, STUBBS, EMERSON, SARGENT, ZAMARRIPA, POPE, MILROY, SPREITZER, SINICKI, ANDERSON, BILLINGS, VRUWINK, CONSIDINE, BROSTOFF and KOLSTE, cosponsored by Senators ERPENBACH, SHILLING, FEYEN, WIRCH, SMITH, RINGHAND and JOHNSON. Referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

1 AN ACT *to create* 71.98 (10) of the statutes; **relating to:** distributions from a 2 federal college savings plan to pay principal and interest on qualified education 3 loans and for materials and equipment used in an apprenticeship program.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill adopts, for state income tax purposes, changes to the federal Internal Revenue Code that allow a person to exclude from the person's gross income distributions from a college savings plan to pay principal and interest on qualified education loans or to pay for materials and equipment used to participate in an apprenticeship program registered with and certified by the federal secretary of labor.

Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.
