## 2019 SENATE BILL 119

March 20, 2019 – Introduced by Senators BERNIER and CARPENTER, cosponsored by Representatives SNYDER, STEINEKE, RODRIGUEZ, PRONSCHINSKE, KURTZ, PLUMER, DITTRICH, JAMES, TITTL, MURSAU, FELZKOWSKI, ROHRKASTE, SPIROS, STEFFEN, ALLEN, DUCHOW, KULP, PETRYK, PETERSEN, THIESFELDT, TUSLER, SCHRAA, MURPHY, KITCHENS, KRUG, EDMING, SUBECK and SINICKI. ### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides an additional \$900,000 in each fiscal year of the 2019–21 fiscal biennium for grants to provide housing and associated supportive services to homeless individuals and families.
