### **2019 SENATE BILL 148**

April 4, 2019 - Introduced by Senators Jacque, Testin, Bernier, Carpenter, Olsen and Schachtner, cosponsored by Representatives Tittl, Tusler, Ballweg, Edming, Emerson, James, Krug, Murphy, Mursau, Petersen, Petryk, Pronschinske, Ramthun, Skowronski, Snyder and VanderMeer. Referred to Committee on Insurance, Financial Services, Government Oversight and Courts.

AN ACT to amend 753.06 (4) (a), 753.06 (4) (c), 753.06 (4) (dm), 753.06 (7) (ag), 753.06 (7) (ar), 753.06 (7) (e), 753.06 (9) (e), 753.06 (9) (g), 753.06 (9) (L), 753.06 (10) (f), 753.06 (10) (g) and 753.06 (10) (L) of the statutes; relating to: adding a circuit court branch in Adams, Calumet, Clark, Dunn, Eau Claire, Jackson, Langlade, Manitowoc, Marathon, Sawyer, Vilas, and Waushara counties.

This bill adds one additional circuit court branch for Adams, Calumet, Clark, Dunn, Eau Claire, Jackson, Langlade, Manitowoc, Marathon, Sawyer, Vilas, and Waushara counties effective August 1, 2020.
