2019 SENATE BILL 445

September 23, 2019 - Introduced by Senators Hansen and Ringhand, cosponsored by Representatives Gruszynski, Bowen, Considine, Crowley and Ohnstad. Referred to Committee on Economic Development, Commerce and Trade.

AN ACT to amend 20.866 (1) (u); and to create 13.48 (46h), 20.866 (2) (zcu) and 20.867 (3) (cu) of the statutes; relating to: 2019-21 Authorized State Building Program, grant to the Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, granting bonding authority, and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill amends the 2019–21 Authorized State Building Program to add a grant to the Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, to assist in the construction of a visitor information and education center in Brown County. The project has a combined cost of \$7,000,000 (\$2,000,000 in general fund supported borrowing authority and \$5,000,000 in gifts, grants, and other receipts).

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 13.48 (46h) of the statutes is created to read:

13.48 (46h) Experience Greater Green Bay Visitor Information and

EDUCATION CENTER. (a) The legislature finds and determines that the tourism

industry is of vital importance in creating jobs and contributing to economic development and tourism in this state and is a statewide responsibility of statewide dimension. It is therefore in the public interest, and it is the public policy of this state, to assist the Experience Greater Green Bay Corporation and Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., in the construction of a visitor information and education center in Brown County.

- (b) The building commission may authorize up to \$2,000,000 in general fund supported borrowing to assist the Experience Greater Green Bay Corporation and Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., in the construction of a visitor information and education center in Brown County. The state funding commitment shall be in the form of a grant to the Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc. Before approving any state funding commitment for the construction of the visitor information and education center, the building commission shall determine that the Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., has secured additional funding for the project of at least \$5,000,000 from nonstate revenue sources.
- (c) If the building commission authorizes a grant to the Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., under par. (b), and if, for any reason, the space that is constructed with funds from the grant is not used for visitor information and education, the state shall retain an ownership interest in the constructed space equal to the amount of the state's grant.
- **Section 2.** 20.866 (1) (u) of the statutes, as affected by 2019 Wisconsin Act 9, is amended to read:

SECTION 3. 20.866 (2) (zcu) of the statutes is created to read:

20.866 (2) (zcu) Experience Greater Green Bay Visitor Information and Education Center. From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the building commission to provide a grant to the Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., for the construction of the visitor information and education center specified in s. 13.48 (46h). The state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 for this purpose.

Section 4. 20.867 (3) (cu) of the statutes is created to read:

20.867 (3) (cu) Principal repayment, interest, and rebates; Experience Greater Green Bay Visitor Information and Education Center. A sum sufficient to reimburse s. 20.866 (1) (u) for the payment of principal and interest costs incurred in financing the construction of the visitor information and education center specified in s. 13.48 (46h), to make the payments determined by the building commission under s. 13.488

construction of the visitor information and education center, as enumerated in sub.			
(1), under s. 13.48 $(46h)$, unless the department of administration has reviewed and			
approved plans for the project. Notwithstanding ss. $16.85\ (1)$ and $16.855\ (1m)$, the			
department of administration may not supervise any services or work or let any			
contract for the project. Section 16.87 does not apply to the project.
