1 AN ACT to create 20.395 (5) (db) of the statutes; relating to: funding the Drug

Evaluation and Classification Program and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill appropriates \$125,000 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$250,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 for the Department of Transportation's Drug Evaluation and Classification Program. The program provides training for law enforcement officers and others in the recognition of drug influence and impairment.
