2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 788

Rodriguez, Shelton, Sinicki, Snodgrass, Spreitzer, Stubbs, Subeck and Vining, cosponsored by Senators Ringhand, Erpenbach, Roys, Agard, L. Taylor, Smith, Pfaff and Larson. Referred to Committee on Government Accountability and Oversight.

AN ACT *to create* 20.115 (7) (u) and 93.74 of the statutes; **relating to:** grants for regional biodigesters, granting rule-making authority, and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection to provide grants for establishing regional biodigesters. Biodigesters are used to break down organic material into gas, liquids, and solids.
