1     **Relating to:** recognizing May 5, 2021, as National Bike to School Day.

2             Whereas, Bike to School Day allows kids, families, and community members  
3 the opportunity to physically participate in the joy of active commuting to school; and

4             Whereas, Bike to School Day supports and sustains healthy communities with  
5 active students and families and safer streets; and

6             Whereas, creating safe walk and bike plans with routes to school for active  
7 commuting through collaborative partnerships can lead to policy and environmental  
8 changes in communities; and

9             Whereas, Bike to School Day supports the whole child approach to academic  
10 achievement through physical activity; and

11            Whereas, increasing equitable, safe, and accessible biking opportunities for  
12 all—but especially for children from low-income households, Black and Brown  
13 children, recent immigrants, and children who are differently abled—grows  
14 community, supports mental and physical well-being, and strengthens autonomy;
