1 AN ACT relating to: location of deaths from COVID-19.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to collect and report to the legislature the living situation location of all deaths from COVID-19 by June 30, 2022.

- (1) Reporting location of COVID-19 deaths.
- (a) In this subsection, "COVID-19" means the infection caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, including any viral variant derived from SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.
