## **2021 SENATE BILL 1084**

March 9, 2022 – Introduced by Senator SMITH. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Energy.

1 AN ACT *to create* 709.03 (form) F20m. and 709.033 (form) E22m. of the statutes; 2 **relating to:** disclosure of contracts for frac sand mining on neighboring 3 properties.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with certain exceptions, an owner selling residential real property or vacant land must give a prospective buyer a form, known as a real estate condition report for residential real property and known as the vacant land disclosure report for vacant land (real estate condition report), on which the owner discloses certain conditions of, and other information about, the real property of which the owner is aware. This bill requires an owner to also disclose on the applicable real estate condition report whether the owner has notice or knowledge of a contract, or an option to contract, that allows a person to mine frac sand on a neighboring property.
