August 26, 2021 – Introduced by Senators LARSON, CARPENTER, AGARD and JOHNSON, cosponsored by Representatives BROSTOFF, ANDERSON, SINICKI, ANDRACA, HEBL, SHANKLAND, OHNSTAD, BALDEH, NEUBAUER, SNODGRASS, CABRERA, MILROY, POPE, CONLEY and SHELTON. Referred to Committee on Elections, Election Process Reform and Ethics.

AN ACT to amend 11.0204 (1) (a) 3., 11.0304 (1) (a) 3., 11.0404 (1) (a) 3., 11.0504 (1) (a) 3., 11.0604 (1) (a) 3., 11.0704 (1) (b) 2., 11.0804 (1) (a) 2. and 11.0904 (1) (a) 3. of the statutes; relating to: reporting a contributor's place of employment.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires any committee that receives campaign finance contributions of more than \$100, cumulatively, from an individual to report the name and address of the individual's principal place of employment and occupation, if any. Current law requires the committee to report the occupation of an individual contributor who makes contributions of more than \$200, cumulatively.
