2021 SENATE BILL 772

December 17, 2021 - Introduced by Senators Smith, Larson, Roys, Erpenbach, Agard, L. Taylor and Pfaff, cosponsored by Representatives B. - of the statutes; **relating to:** county conservation staff for climate change resiliency purposes and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, as part of the Soil and Water Resource Management program, DATCP provides funding to counties for county conservation staffing. Current law specifies the activities that county conservation staff may engage in with funding provided under this program. The bill provides that this program may be used to fund county conservation staff who focus on climate change and climate change resiliency. The bill provides \$1,800,000 in GPR funding for this purpose. Under the bill, a county that seeks funding for this purpose must specifically indicate so in its annual grant request.

(1) Special education aid. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the
